#### 3.0 NEW BUSINESS

- 3.1 Proposals for New Business
- 3.2 McGrath mentioned that the "Triangle" property across from the Fire Station on Kirby had been sold to a church congregation. Since churches are permitted in the R-2 zone, he did not anticipate any zoning issues. Ms. Smith expressed concern about drainage from the church property into abutting properties in Clear Lake Forest. There have been water issues in the past and roofing/paving large areas of the property are likely to increase the water flow unless something is done. She said she is communication with CLCWA over the drainage. CLCWA is the proper forum for that concern.

McGrath also mentioned that a developer is interested in the property at the intersection of NASA Parkway and Kirby Road and is working on a comprehensive plan to develop that tract. It

is still very preliminary and commercial negotiations are taking place. P&Z had not received a plan and can not take any action until we do.
